**Highlights**

Dr. William "Rob" Roberts, was recognized by eSchoolNews as one of ten superintendents as a "Tech-Savvy Superintendent for his outstanding leadership and vision in the area of educational technology. Enrollment this year increased to more than 6,150 students dispersed over 18,000 square miles in seven diverse communities.

Nye County School District is addressing the needs of our gifted and talented students in Pahrump with two pilot programs. A hands-on science lab was set up at J. G. Johnson Elementary School. This lab was utilized by fourth and fifth grade students from all four elementary school. At the middle and high school level, teachers are being trained to teach pre-AP and AP classes. A team of eight teachers will attend the national AP conference in Orlando, FL. The team of high school teachers will also attend the Silver State AP conference this summer.

Nye County School District is proud of the achievement of Tonopah Middle School and Tonopah High School, which were both designated as High Achieving for the 2004-2005 school year. In addition, Beatty High School received a designation of High Achieving for an increase in the number of proficient students.
