Fast Flux Test Facility Draft Request For Proposals Now Available

The draft Request for Proposals (RFP) for the work to clean up and take down the Fast Flux Test Facility (FFTF) complex at the U.S. Department of Energy's (DOE) Hanford Site in Southeastern Washington State is now available at <http://doe-iips.pr.doe.gov>.

DOE has designated the work as a small business set-aside (companies with fewer than 500 employees). Worth up to \$500 million, it is the largest small business set-aside in DOE to date. DOE anticipates that all cleanup work under the contract will be completed by 2012.

DOE intends to issue the final RFP by December.
