Lethality Assessment

There is no magic formula to determine if there is a high risk of suicide of homicide from the batterer. This questionnaire may help to identify compounding risks to the victim. If she feels her life is in danger take this very seriously. If she does not believe she is a risk but you have concerns of immediate danger discuss this with her frankly.
