## **Japanese Beetles**

Prevent live Japanese beetles from hitching a ride on aircraft destined for Arizona, California, Idaho, Nevada, Oregon, Utah, and Washington. Keep all doors and hatches closed before and immediately after loading.

A voracious feeder, the Japanese beetle causes extensive damage to many varieties of ornamental plants, shrubs, trees, vines, and crops. This pest has a metallic green body, bronze wing covers, and six white spots on each side of its body. It is approximately 1/2 inch long.

Japanese beetles are extremely mobile during the hottest part of the day. The best time to look for them at airports is during a hot, sunny day.
