PUBLIC PRINTER ADDRESSES PRINTING INDUSTRY ON SUSTAINABLE ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP

WASHINGTON— Public Printer Robert C. Tapella outlined ways the printing and paper industries can attain sustainable environmental stewardship in the address, *GPO and the American Printing Industry Move Forward with Sustainable Environmental Stewardship*, to industry leaders from around the world at **drupa 2008** in Düsseldorf, Germany. In January, Tapella set goals on this issue for the U.S. Government Printing Office (GPO) and is now taking the next steps to achieving those goals.

drupa is the largest printing equipment exhibition in the world. The event takes place every four to five years. In 2004, nearly 400,000 attended.
