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Columbia Forest Products Only Bidder on BLM Timber Sale

Klamath Falls - The Klamath Falls Resource Area of the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) held the PVJ Timber Sale on August 27.

The tract of timber offered is located in Klamath County, approximately 20 miles southwest of Klamath Falls. The sale is estimated to contain 1,268,000 board feet of timber with an appraised value of \$55,268.70.

Columbia Forest Products was the only qualified bidder at the event. The company submitted a bid for the appraised price.
