## BLM to temporarily close Bodkins Road #24-8-25.2

The Bureau of Land Management will soon be replacing a rusted out culvert with a new 60-inch diameter culvert on the Tyee Access/Bodkins Road near Miner Wolf Creek (BLM Road No. 24-8-25.2) approximately 3/4 mile up the Tyee access bridge road. To ensure safety for the public and work crews, approximately 2.5 miles of Bodkin Road will be closed from Sept 6-15.

About the BLM -- The BLM manages more land – 258 million surface acres – than any other Federal agency. Most of this public land is located in 12 Western states, including Alaska. The BLM, with a budget of about \$1.8 billion, also administers 700 million acres of sub-surface mineral estate throughout the nation.
