Mr. Daniels' organization offers a variety of learning resources and techniques, including a series of financial education seminars for students of historical black colleges and universities.

Mr. Daniels was recently appointed to President Bush's Advisory Council on Financial Literacy. He also serves a member of the Board of Directors of the Certified Financial Planners Board of Standards. During his career, he has written a financial education newsletter and a syndicated personal financial education column, and produced a syndicated financial education television series broadcast on the Public Broadcasting System (PBS) and cable systems nationwide. Mr. Daniels has a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration with a concentration in Economics and Accounting from Fort Valley State University and a Bachelor of Laws degree from John Marshall School. He is also an honorary member of the Golden Key Honor Society and Sigma Beta Delta International Honor Society in Business, Management and Administration.
