RSR Motor Replacement Procedure

I. Purpose:

This procedure describes the steps necessary to replace a RSR motor.

II. Cautions and Hazards:

None.

III. Requirements:

- New motor.
- Screwdriver.

IV. Procedure:

A. Steps:

- 1. Turn power "OFF" to RSR by disconnecting RSR fuse.
- Remove cable to band motor.
- 3. Remove the pinch screw from the latitude adjustment; the entire band motor should come off.

Note: Make marks for latitude adjustment location.

4. Remove band by unscrewing the set screw.

Note: When installing a new band motor (or reusing the old motor), be sure to push the band piece all the way into the motor.

- 5. Add new motor and band by reversing these steps.
- 6. Record start-time, end-time, date, and comments on the site operations checklist.
