Power Cycling TSI

I. Purpose:

This procedure describes how to power cycle the Total Sky Imager (TSI).

IV. Procedure:

A. Power Cycling TSI

1. Power off the TSI by turning off the main switch.
2. Wait 3 to 4 minutes to be sure that the on-board computer had gracefully shut down.
3. Turn on the main power switch.
4. Wait 5 minutes to make sure that the on-board computer has completely booted back up.
5. Unplug the camera Internet connector.
6. Wait 1 to 2 minutes.
7. Plug in the camera.
8. Test to see if images are being collected. If not, repeat the steps 4 through 8.
