In accordance with provisions of the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969, we have enclosed for your review the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) Draft Programmatic Environmental Impact Statement (DPEIS) for Steller Sea Lion and Northern Fur Seal Research.

This DPEIS analyzes the potential environmental impacts of implementing the NOAA's National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) future grants and Endangered Species Act/Marine Mammal Protection Act permit programs related to research on northern fur seals and threatened and endangered Steller sea lions throughout their ranges in the United States.
