1. January 02, 2003- <u>CSX Transportation (CSX), Union City, Georgia</u> A road switcher collided with standing cars while backing on an industrial track.

2. January 02, 2003- <u>Union Pacific Railroad (UP), Towers, Nebraska</u> A coal train, operating at 49 mph, derailed 43 cars.

3. January 06, 2003- <u>Southern California Regional Rail Authority (SCAX)</u>, Buena Vista, CA A highway vehicle was struck by a commuter train at a highway-rail grade crossing.

4. January 14, 2003- <u>Iowa Chicago & Eastern Railroad (ICE), Lawler, Iowa</u> A grain train, operating at 27 mph, derailed 21 cars.

5. January 22, 2003- <u>CSX Transportation (CSX), Brownsville, Tennessee</u> A freight train, operating at 42 mph, entered a siding at a misaligned hand operated switch and collided with two unattended locomotives.

6. January 25, 2003- <u>CSX Transportation (CSX)</u>, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania Rear-end collision.

7. February 5, 2003- <u>Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF)</u>, <u>Silsbee</u>, <u>Texas</u> A runaway cut of cars collided with the locomotives that were in pursuit of those cars.

8. February 9, 2003- <u>Canadian National Illinois Central (CNIC)</u>, <u>Tamaroa</u>, <u>Illinois</u> A mixed freight train, operating at 41 mph, derailed 22 cars. An evacuation was ordered.

9. February 10, 2003- <u>Amtrak/Canadian National Illinois Central (CNIC)</u>, <u>Pinckneyville, IL</u>. An Amtrak train, operating at 60 mph, derailed the ninth head car of the train.

10. February 10, 2003- <u>Norfolk Southern (NS), Montevallo, Alabama</u> A freight train, operating at 26 mph, derailed 34 cars.

11. February 11, 2003- <u>Union Pacific (UP) North Dupo, Illinois</u> A switch engine collided head-on with a freight train.

12. February 11, 2003- <u>Norfolk Southern (NS), Radford, Virginia</u> A coal train, operating at 30 mph, derailed three locomotives and 17 cars.

13. February 13, 2003- <u>Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF)</u>, Scotts Bluff, Nebraska Side collision.

14. February 14, 2003- <u>Norfolk Southern (NS), Farmington, Delaware</u> A freight train, operating at 25 mph, derailed six cars. Five cars contained hazardous materials. An evacuation was ordered.

15. February 20, 2003- <u>Canadian National Illinois Central (CNIC)</u>, <u>Hobart, Indiana</u> A freight train, operating at 60 mph, derailed 35 cars.

16. February 25, 2003- <u>Norfolk Southern (NS), Johnstown, Pennsylvania</u> A freight train, operating at 34 mph, derailed 21 cars.

17. February 28, 2003- <u>Norfolk Southern (NS), Blacksburg, Virginia</u> A coal train, operating at 26 mph, derailed 33 cars.

18. March 02, 2003- <u>Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF)</u>, Brush, Colorado Rear end collision.

19. March 04, 2003- <u>CSX Transportation (CSX), New Orleans, Louisiana</u> A train departing the yard derailed six cars into a standing train.

20. March 06, 2003- <u>Union Pacific (UP) Akron, Illinois</u> A coal train, operating at 46 mph, derailed 48 cars.

21. March 10, 2003- <u>Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF)</u>, Seattle, Washington A freight train, operating at 18 mph, struck the side of an opposing train.

22. March 11, 2003- <u>Norfolk Southern (NS), Ashtabula, Ohio</u> A freight train, operating at 7 mph, collided head-on with a standing train.

23. March 13, 2003- <u>CSX Transportation (CSX), Holten, Tennessee</u> A freight train, operating at 22 mph, collided head-on with a hi-rail vehicle.

24. March 13, 2003- <u>Kansas City Southern (KCS)</u>, <u>Baton Rouge</u>, <u>Louisiana</u> A yard train employee was injured during a remote control switching operation</u>.

25. March 18, 2003- <u>Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF)</u>, Clarenden, Texas A freight train, operating at 49 mph, derailed two locomotives and 28 cars.

26. March 21, 2003- <u>Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF)</u>, New Castle, Wyoming A unit coal train, operating at 50 mph, derailed 35 cars.

27. March 22, 2003- Kansas City Southern (KCS), Kansas City, Missouri Side collision.

28. March 28, 2003- <u>Union Pacific (UP) Gering, Nebraska</u> A unit coal train, operating at 50 mph, derailed 24 cars.

29. March 29, 2003- <u>Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF)</u>, Ogles, Texas A freight train, operating at 48 mph, derailed 28 cars.

30. March 30, 2003- <u>Canadian National (CN)</u>, <u>Bellevue</u>, <u>Michigan</u> A unit coal train, operating at 38 mph, derailed 25 cars.

31. April 01, 2003- <u>Norfolk Southern (NS)</u>, <u>Surrency</u>, <u>Georgia</u> A freight train, operating at 49 mph, derailed 25 cars.

32. April 05, 2003- <u>Canadian Pacific (CP), Red Wing, Minnesota</u> A freight train, operating at 40 mph, derailed 29 cars.

33. April 05, 2003- <u>Norfolk Southern (NS)</u>, <u>Sheffield</u>, <u>Ohio</u> A Sperry Rail detector car, operating at 28 mph, collided with the side of a freight train.

34. April 11, 2003- <u>Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF)</u>, Olathe, Kansas A unit coal train, operating at 47 mph, derailed 27 cars.

35. April 11, 2003- <u>Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF)</u>, <u>Slaton</u>, <u>Texas</u> A freight train, operating at 4 mph, derailed 6 cars resulting in a release of hazardous material and subsequent evacuation.

36. April 15, 2003- <u>Canadian National Illinois Central (CNIC)</u>, Jackson, Mississippi A freight train, operating at 50 mph, derailed 25 cars.

37. April 15, 2003- <u>Union Pacific (UP) Marlin, Texas</u> A freight train, operating at 45 mph, derailed 26 cars.

38. April 15, 2003- Union Pacific (UP) Roseville, California

A remote control yard switcher made a back-up move through a misaligned switch and derailed one car onto its side. The car struck the lead locomotive on another yard job.

39. May 01, 2003- <u>Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF)</u>, Lapine, Oregon A freight train collided head-on with a hi-rail vehicle.

40. May 02, 2003-<u>Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF)</u>, Seattle, Washington A freight train, operating at 5 mph, struck the rear-end of another train.

41. May 04, 2003- <u>CSX Transportation (CSX), Flomaton, Alabama</u> A freight train, operating at 20 mph, struck the rear-end of another train.

42. May 05, 2003- <u>CSX Transportation (CSX), Tarrant, Alabama</u> A remote controlled yard switcher collided with the side of another yard switcher.

43. May 06, 2003- <u>Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF)</u>, <u>Dant</u>, <u>Texas</u> A freight train, operating at 19 mph, collided with a hi-rail vehicle</u>.

44. May 05, 2003- <u>Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF)</u>, <u>Hazard</u>, <u>Nebraska</u> A work train collided with the rear end of another train. The resulting derailment struck a third train standing on the adjacent main track.

45. May 06, 2003- <u>Amtrak (ATK)/CSX Transportation (CSX), McIntosh, Georgia</u> An Amtrak passenger train, operating at 79 mph, struck a tractor trailer loaded with plywood at a highway/rail grade crossing.

46. May 06, 2003- <u>Union Pacific (UP) Carroll, Iowa</u>

An westbound auto train, operating at 61 mph, derailed into an eastbound freight train operating at 50 mph on the adjacent main track.

47. May 17, 2003- <u>Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF)</u>, <u>Matfield Green</u>, <u>Kansas</u> An eastbound freight train, struck the side of a westbound freight train.

48. May 28, 2003- <u>Amtrak (ATK)/Union Pacific (UP), Dotsero, Colorado</u> An Amtrak passenger train, operating at 38 mph, derailed 2 cars.

49. June 02, 2003-<u>CSX Transportation (CSX), Atherton, Indiana</u> An Intermodal train, operating at 50 mph, derailed eight cars resulting in an explosion and fire.

50. June 17, 2003- <u>Norfolk Southern (NS), Richwood, Kentucky</u> A freight train, operating at 58 mph, struck a vehicle at a highway-rail grade crossing.

51. June 19, 2003- <u>CSX Transportation (CSX), Cumberland, Maryland</u> A westbound container train, operating at 28 mph, collided head-on with a freight train operating at 11 mph. 52. June 20, 2003- <u>Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF)</u>, <u>Minneapolis</u>, <u>Minnesota</u> A remote control yard switcher, operating at 9 mph, derailed 42 cars.

53. June 20, 2003- <u>Union Pacific (UP), City of Commerce, California</u> Runaway cars rolled out of a siding onto the main track and subsequently derailed.

54. June 21, 2003- <u>CSX Transportation (CSX), Blasdell, New York</u> A freight train, operating at 49 mph, derailed 29 cars.

55. July 14, 2003- <u>New Jersey Transit (NJT)/Amtrak (ATK) Secaucus, New Jersey</u> A NJT passenger train, operating at 60 mph, derailed three cars.

56. July 28, 2003- <u>Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF)/ Union Pacific (UP)</u>, Bisbee, Texas A freight train, operating at 20 mph, collided head-on with a standing train.

57. July 30, 2003- <u>CSX Transportation (CSX), Holland, Michigan</u> Four Maintenance-of-Way employees were struck by a ballast regulator while performing track work.

58. July 31, 2003- <u>Union Pacific (UP), Dunsmuir, California</u> A freight train, operating at 20 mph, derailed 15 cars.

59. August 14, 2003- <u>Union Pacific (UP), Wallace, Louisiana</u> A freight train, operating at 39 mph, derailed 47 cars.

60. September 7, 2003- <u>Union Pacific (UP), Beaumont, California</u> A freight train, operating in double track territory, derailed 18 cars which were subsequently struck by a passing train resulting in the passing train derailing 3 locomotives and eight cars.

61. September 8, 2003- <u>Union Pacific (UP), Riner, Wyoming</u> A freight train, operating at 41 mph, derailed 27 cars.

62. September 17, 2003- <u>Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF)</u>, Chriesman, Texas A freight train, operating at 13 mph, struck the rear-end of another train.

63. September 18, 2003- <u>Patapsco & Black Rivers (PBR)/Norfolk Southern (NS), Baltimore MD</u> A PBR freight train, operating at 7 mph, collided head-on with a standing NS train.

64. October 1, 2003- <u>Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF), Udall, Kansas</u> A BNSF freight train struck a Hi-Rail vehicle that was sitting on the main track working near an interlocking.

65. October 7, 2003- <u>CSX Transportation (CSX), Leland, North Carolina</u> A remote control activated locomotive was working in a yard when it struck another switching movement.

66. October 12, 2003- <u>Metra Commuter Service (Metra), Chicago, Illinois</u> Commuter train No. 519 derailed both locomotives and all five cars as it was entering a crossover switch at 49th Street.

67. October 18, 2003- <u>Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF)</u>, <u>Hale Center, Texas</u> A freight train, operating at 49 mph, struck a vehicle at a highway crossing at grade. As a result of the collision, three people were killed and three others were injured.

68. November 15, 2003- <u>Union Pacific (UP)/Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF)</u>, Longview, Washington A UP Intermodal train, operating at 50 mph, struck the side of a BNSF Intermodal train.

69. November 19, 2003-CSX Transportation (CSX), Opelika, Alabama

A CSX Hi-Rail vehicle that was operating behind a CSX coal train struck the rear of the train stopped on the main line ahead of them.

70. November 22, 2003- <u>Norfolk Southern (NS), Cordova, Alabama</u> A freight train, operating at 18 mph, derailed 23 cars.

71. November 23, 2003- <u>Union Pacific (UP),Dunlap, Illinois</u> A freight train, operating at 45 mph, derailed 30 cars. A railroad bridge was destroyed.

72. December 8, 2003- <u>Union Pacific (UP), Los Angeles, California</u> An Aurant Yard UP switcher, struck the side of an arriving UP Intermodal train.

73. December 16, 2003- <u>Union Pacific (UP), Sunset Whitney, California</u> A freight train, operating at 48 mph, derailed 26 cars.

74. December 18, 2003- <u>CSX Transportation (CSX), Alexandria, Virginia</u> A freight train, operating North through Alexandria Interlocking, derailed 20 cars. Passenger train service was disrupted.

75. December 23, 2003- <u>Union Pacific (UP)</u>, <u>Bridgeport, Colorado</u> A freight train, operating at 33 mph, derailed 32 cars.

76. December 29, 2003- <u>Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF)</u>, <u>Pauls Valley</u>, <u>Oklahoma</u> A Westbound train, traveling at 4 mph, struck the side of an Eastbound train traveling at 14 mph.
