
#### **Camp Drop-Off and Pick-Up Locations**

At the Aquarium and Garden: Park in the southwest lot at the intersection of Central and Tingley Blvd. Drop off and pick up campers inside the Education Annex Building.

Campers in classes which visit Tingley Beach should be dropped off at the Aquarium/Garden.
