REFUND POLICY: Requests for a camp refund must be received in writing by BioPark Education **three weeks prior to the first day of class**. Call 764-6245 to confirm your letter has been received. Written requests must state the reason for the camp refund, name of child, name of camp class, your name, address, social security number of person receiving the refund, method of payment used at time of registration and amount paid. A \$25 processing fee, per class/per child, will be deducted from all refunds issued. Once the class begins, no partial refunds can be issued. Please allow adequate time for the City of Albuquerque to process the request. No other refunds will be given.

Step Four: Sign Camp BioPark 2008 Consent Form

I am the parent or lawful guardian of _____, a minor (hereafter "child"), who will be participating in the CAMP BIOPARK 2008 program (hereafter "Program"). I hereby acknowledge that I am aware that this Program may involve a higher level of activity at the BioPark for my child than normal BioPark attendance, and that my child may be allowed into areas of the BioPark not usually open to the general public. I also acknowledge that my child may have some contact with animals and that, although the BioPark will take reasonable precautions for my child's safety, he/she may be subject to some additional risk. I understand and agree to have my child properly outfitted and clothed for said Program (see page 4 for details). I am aware that each camp is tailored to the physical and mental maturity of a specified grade level and that it is my responsibility to ensure my child is enrolled in the correct grade-specific group. If BioPark Education discovers that I knowingly enrolled my child in the incorrect grade-specific group, they will remove my child from the Program without a refund.

I agree that I have taken such measures as I have deemed advisable to ascertain that my child's physical condition is suitable for the Program. If my child has any medical considerations or special needs, I will bring these to the attention of BioPark staff prior to my child beginning the Program. If I cannot be reached in an emergency, I authorize treatment by a physician.

The BioPark cannot be held responsible for children left unattended prior to or following each day's camp session. I understand that it is my responsibility for my child to be picked up on time, and I will make all the necessary arrangements to see that he/she is picked up no later than 4:00pm (or noon for morning classes).

I further confirm that my child is covered by a medical insurance policy and, in the event he/she is injured, I will either pay for the medical expenses and other damages or make a claim for my insurance company to pay. In consideration of the City allowing my child to participate in the Program, which I consider to be of great benefit to him/her, I hereby agree to indemnify, release, defend and hold harmless the City for any liability or expenses which exceed medical policy limits incurred as a result of any injuries suffered by my child while participating in the Program, unless such injuries are caused by the gross negligence of the City or its employees.

By signing below, I give permission for my child to participate in the Program. I acknowledge that I have carefully read and agree to the foregoing.

- Video games

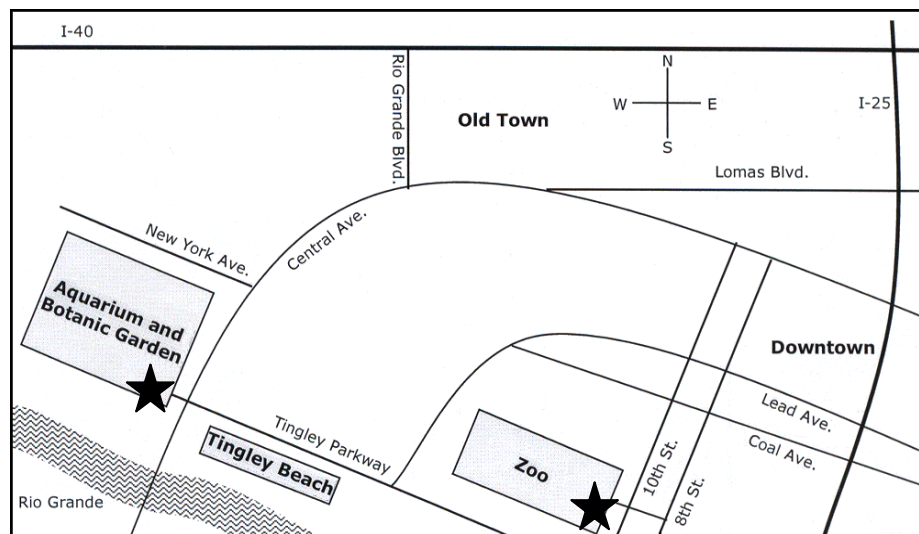
Full-day campers also need to bring a lunch.

Campers in classes which visit Tingley Beach should be dropped off at the Aquarium/Garden.
