Fisher to Serve as Acting Director of Public Affairs and Government Relations

Washington, DC – Postal Regulatory Commission Chairman Dan G. Blair today announced that Ann Fisher, Chief of Staff of the Postal Regulatory Commission, would serve as Acting Director of the Commission's Office of Public Affairs and Government Relations. This position was previously held by Nanci Langley, who was sworn in yesterday as a Commissioner.

Fisher has served as the Commission's Chief of Staff since January 2007. Previously, she served as deputy staff director for the Senate Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs. She was the principal advisor to Senator Susan Collins on postal matters and served as the chief staff architect of the Postal Accountability and Enhancement Act. Prior to her work for Senator Collins, Fisher served on the Senate Governmental Affairs Subcommittee on International Security, Proliferation and Federal Services. She also worked for the United States Postal Service performing government relations.
