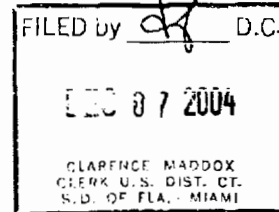

**CONSENT ORDER GRANTING PRELIMINARY INJUNCTIVE RELIEF**

Plaintiff Commodity Futures Trading Commission ("CFTC") has filed a complaint against Defendants Liberty Financial Trading Corp., Inc. ("LFT"), Liberty Real Assets Investment Corporation ("LRAI"), Ted Romeo ("Romeo"), Randy Burstein ("Burstein"), Nader Yazdani ("Yazdani") and Leslie Weiner ("Weiner") (collectively, "Defendants") seeking a permanent injunction and other relief and moved for a preliminary injunction. The Court hereby enters a Consent Order Granting Preliminary Injunctive Relief as to all Defendants and orders as follows:

**I. JURISDICTION AND VENUE**

1. This Court has jurisdiction over Defendants and the subject matter of this case pursuant to Section 6c(a) of the Commodity Exchange Act, as Amended, 7 U.S.C. § 13a-1(a) (2001) (the "Act").

2. Venue properly lies with this Court pursuant to Section 6c(e) of the Act, 7 U.S.C. § 13a-1(e).

## II. PROHIBITIONS FROM VIOLATIONS OF THE ACT

3. Defendants, all persons insofar as they are acting in the capacity of agents, servants, employees, assigns, of Defendants, and all persons insofar as they are acting in active concert or participation with Defendants who receive actual notice of this Order by personal service or otherwise, shall be prohibited and restrained from directly or indirectly:


- A. entering into or confirming the execution of, any transaction involving any commodity regulated under this Act which is of the character of, or is commonly known to the trade as, an "option," "privilege," "indemnity," "bid," "offer," "put," "call," "advance guaranty," or "decline guaranty" contrary to any rule, regulation, or order of the Commission prohibiting any such transaction or allowing any such transaction under such terms and conditions as the Commission shall prescribe; and
- B. in or in connection with an offer to enter into, the entry into, the confirmation of the execution of, or the maintenance of, any commodity option transaction:
  - (i) cheating or defrauding or attempting to cheat or defraud any other person; or
  - (ii) deceiving or attempting to deceive any other person by any means whatsoever.

## III. FORCE AND EFFECT

**The parties agree and it is further ordered that:**


This Order shall remain in full force and effect until further order of this Court, and that this Court retains jurisdiction of this matter for all purposes. The parties further agree that this Consent Order Granting Preliminary Injunctive Relief shall not be deemed to establish any fact and may not be used or introduced in any other proceeding, including but not limited to actions under § 8a(2)(C) of the Act, for any purpose, except by this Court to enforce this Order in conjunction with its terms.
