A RESOLUTION to adopt the Commission's annual budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008, (July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008) and to apportion among the signatory parties the amounts required for the support of the current expense and capital budgets.

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Delaware River Basin Compact and the Commission's Administrative Manual, the Commission published its proposed current expense and capital budgets for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008 and held a public hearing on the proposed budgets on September 27, 2006 at the Delaware River Basin Commission's headquarters, 25 State Police Drive, West Trenton, New Jersey; now therefore,

## BE IT RESOLVED by unanimous vote of the Delaware River Basin Commission:

- 1. The Current Expense Budget of the Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008 in the aggregate amount of \$5,004,000, and a Capital Budget (Water Supply Storage Facilities Fund) reflecting revenues of \$3,420,500 and expenditures of \$2,744,600, as set forth in the document dated September 27, 2006 and titled "Delaware River Basin Commission Current Expense and Capital Budgets for the Period July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008," incorporated herein, are hereby approved and adopted.
- 2. Pursuant to Section 13.3 of the Compact, and subject to such review and approval as may be required by the respective budgetary processes of the signatory parties, there are hereby apportioned among the parties the following amounts, together with such other funds as may be available to the Commission for the support of the budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008.
