

# CHART 10

There were more than 4.2 million nonfatal injuries and illnesses reported in 2005.

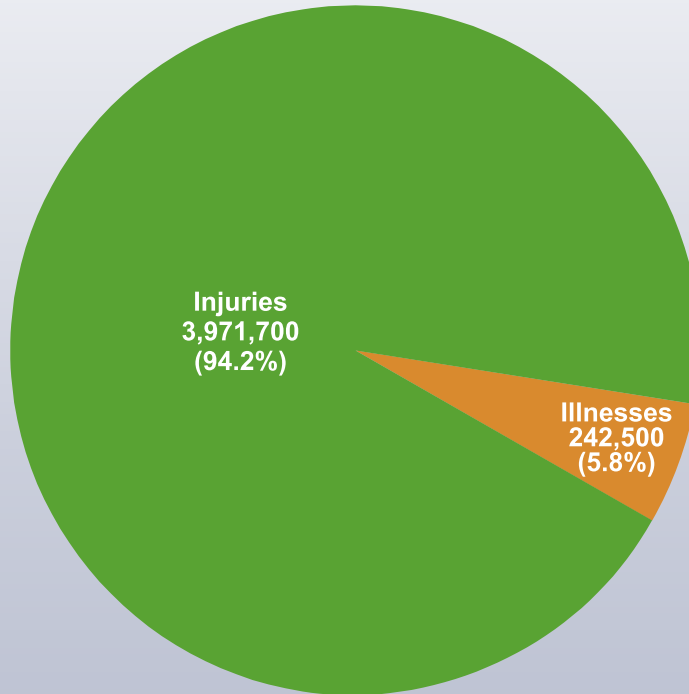
Injuries accounted for nearly 4.0 million, or 94.2 percent, of all nonfatal injuries and illnesses.

The remainder of these private industry cases (242,500) were occupational illnesses.

The distribution of injuries versus illnesses was unchanged from 2004.
