

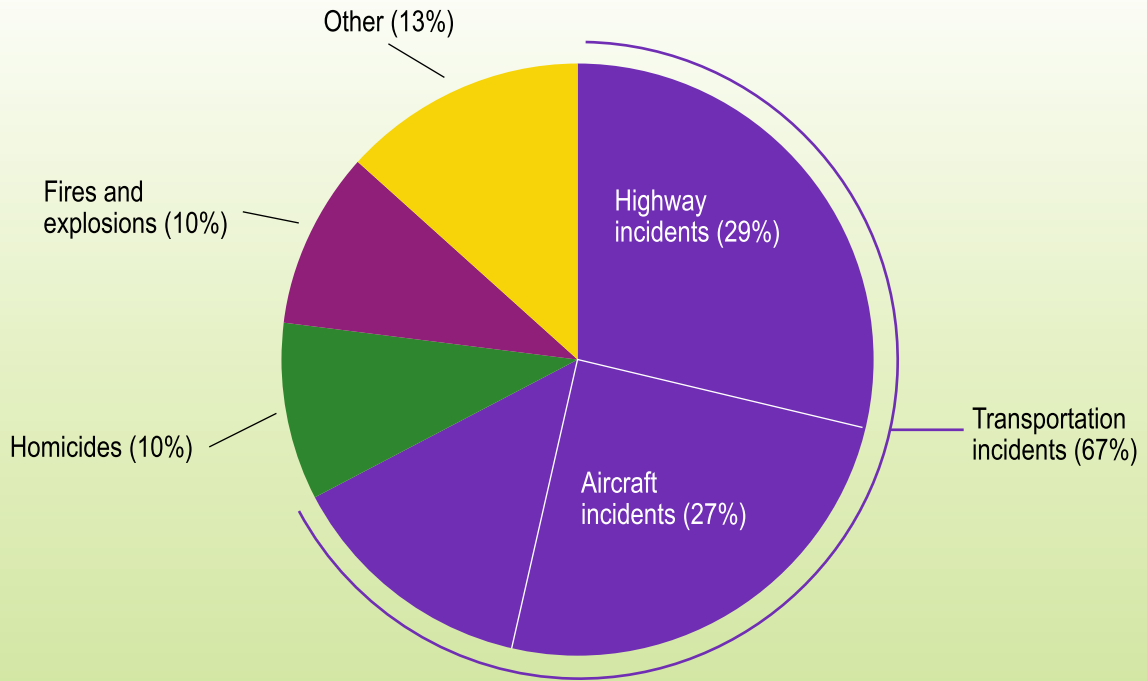

In 2004, 518 workers were killed in multiple-fatality incidents, defined as single incidents in which two or more workers were fatally injured. Thus, about 9 percent of all fatally injured workers in 2004 were killed in multiple-fatality incidents.

Transportation incidents accounted for two-thirds of the workers killed in multiple-fatality incidents. Fatalities resulting from homicides and from fires and explosions each accounted for another one-tenth of these fatalities.
