Written summaries and oral presentations must be restricted to addressing the factual issues presented. The submission of a written summary does not guarantee that an oral presentation will be permitted. The Subcommittees are not seeking advice or recommendations, and any submission that does not conform to this requirement will be rejected.

Seating at the meeting forum is limited; therefore, preference will be given to participants who will be making presentations at the meeting. Other participants will be admitted on a first-come, first-served basis. FinCEN reserves the right to limit the amount of time allotted to speakers in the interest of maximizing opportunities to participate.
