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CEMENT IN APRIL 2008

This report provides monthly data on the shipments of cement to final customers, and the production of clinker, in the United States from January 2007 through the current month.¹ The current report contains extensive revisions to the data for, primarily, northern California and Puerto Rico. Data on the imports of cement and clinker for the current month are also provided.

Total shipments of portland and blended cement in the United States and Puerto Rico for April 2008 were about 8.9 million metric tons (Mt). This was 6.3% lower than shipments in April 2007 (tables 2A and 2B). Year-to-date shipments were 28.8 Mt, down by 11.3% from those of the same period in 2007. The leading producing States (Texas, California, Florida, Pennsylvania, and Alabama, descending order) shipped about 39% of the April total (table 1A). The leading consuming States (Texas, California, Florida, Georgia, and Arizona, in descending order) received about 39% of April's total shipments (tables 2A and 2B).

Clinker production totaled about 6.6 Mt, about 11.6% lower than the production in April 2007 (table 4). Year-to-date

production was 25.0 Mt, down by 6.4% compared with that of the same period in 2007. The leading clinker-producing States (Texas, California, Alabama, Pennsylvania, and Florida, in descending order) produced about 42% of the April total.

Masonry cement shipments in April of about 302,000 metric tons (t) were 21.5% lower than shipments for April 2007 (table 2C). Year-to-date shipments were 1.03 Mt, down by about 27% from those of the same period in 2007. The leading consuming States in April, in descending order, were Florida, Texas, California, Georgia, and North Carolina, and these States received about 20% of April's total shipments.

Tables 5, 6, and 7 contain import data from the U.S. Census Bureau. Data for clinker imports into the Seattle and possibly the Detroit customs districts are incomplete owing to some shipments arriving overland from Canada on an informal entry basis. April 2008 imports of cement and clinker were about 1.2 Mt, down by about 41% from imports in April 2007. Year-to-date imports were 3.8 Mt, down by about 46%.
