## MARKETABLE PHOSPHATE ROCK IN JULY 2007

U.S. marketable phosphate rock production in July was 2.58 million metric tons (Mt), which was 3% higher than that in June, according to the U.S. Geological Survey. Production in January through July was 2% lower than in the same period of 2006.

Phosphate rock used in the United States in July was 2.64 Mt, which was 13% higher than in June. Reported use of phosphate rock in January through July was slightly higher than that in the same period of 2006. U.S. producer stocks were 2% lower than those in June and 14% lower than those in July 2006.

Imports of phosphate rock were estimated based on U.S. Census Bureau figures and export data from the Moroccan producer. Morocco supplies more than 99% of the phosphate rock imported into the United States; however, the U.S. Census Bureau suppresses much of the phosphate rock tonnage and value data from Morocco.

Estimated apparent consumption of phosphate rock in 2007, based on annualized data, was 33.3 Mt, compared with 32.6 Mt in 2006.
