#### ENVIRONMENT ENHANCEMENT TO PROMOTE PSYCHOLOGICAL WELL-BEING.

Nonhuman primates may not be housed with other species of primates or animals unless they are compatible, do not prevent access to food, water, or shelter by individual animals, and are not known to be hazardous to the health and well-being of each other.

2 adult Lemurs (primates) are being housed in the same primary enclosure with 3 adult exotic birds called EMU'S. These are not compatible species and must be housed separately to avoid the possibility of injury. To correct his item the EMU'S must be moved to their own enclosure. CORRECT WITHIN 24HRS.

# 3.133

#### SEPARATION.

Section 3.133- Animals housed in the same primary enclosure must be compatible. Animals shall not be housed near animals that interfere with their health or cause them discomfort.

2 adult Lemurs (primates) are being housed in the same primary enclosure with 3 adult exotic birds called EMU'S. These are not compatible species and must be housed separately to avoid the possibility of injury. To correct his item the EMU'S must be moved to their own enclosure. CORRECT WITHIN 24HRS.
