## 2.40 (a)(1)

## ATTENDING VETERINARIAN AND ADEQUATE VETERINARY CARE (DEALERS AND EXHIBITORS).

Section 2.40(a)(1)- Each dealer or exhibitor shall have an attending veterinarian who shall provide adequate veterinary care to its animals in compliance with this section.

(1) Each dealer and exhibitor shall employ an attending veterinarian under formal arrangements. In the case of a part-time attending veterinarian or consultant arrangements, the formal arrangements shall include a written program of veterinary care and regularly scheduled visits to the premises of the dealer or exhibitor.

The written program of veterinary care is not adequate to comply with the provisions set forth in this section of the regulations. Section III (Wild and Exotic Animals) has N/A documented under the primate section. This facility had an adult primate in their possession for 2 days and then it was sold. The attending veterinarian shall, maintain and supervise programs of disease control and prevention, pest and parasite control, pre-procedural and post-procedural care, nutrition, euthanasia and adequate veterinary care for all animals. To correct this item the attending veterinarian must document the primate section and may use additional sheets of paper if needed. CORRECT BY 11-01-05
