

# San Diego County Fires October 2007

- Sunday Oct. 21 –Friday Oct. 26, 2007
- "Santa Ana winds"condition
  - •35 –60 MPH sustained winds from the East
  - •80 MPH gusts
- Total of 7 fires
- Approximately 350,450 acres burned
- 547.5 square miles!
- 1259 structures destroyed

# San Diego County Fires October 2007

- 9 deaths
- Evacuations ordered for approximately 640,000 residents
- Hundreds of miles of commercial infrastructure (power, communications) destroyed.

Southern Indian Health Council, Inc. Response Team

- Monday, October 22<sup>nd</sup>
- We opened with approximately 10 employees present emergency response mobilization began.



#### Southern Indian Health Council, Inc.

- Tuesday, October 23<sup>rd</sup>
- SIHC Alpine and Campo pharmacies opened with 7 staff

Patients contacted, medications distributed



- Wednesday, October 24th
- 75% of SIHC staff present; emergency response meeting and mobilization




- Contacted 350 patients with chronic health and breathing problems
- Dispensed and delivered medications from both Alpine and Campo Clinics
- Performed 23 physician visits in the field
- Transported dialysis patients
- Distributed and prepared 170 Elder meals

Conclusion: The Fires in San Diego County prompted the reallocation of Southern Indian Health Council resources to meet the needs of our community. Our staff, many who were evacuees themselves, contacted patients by phone and delivered medications, meals, water, and breathing masks.
