## PLATINUM-GROUP METALS IN JUNE 2007

According to Platts Metals Week, the June average price of platinum decreased slightly as compared with that of May, while the palladium price increased slightly over the same time period. The average ruthenium price decreased for the second

consecutive month, declining 19% as compared with that of May. The iridium price has not changed since February 13 and has remained at \$450 per troy ounce. The rhodium June average price was slightly lower than the May average price.
