PLATINUM-GROUP METALS IN JULY 2007

According to Platts Metals Week, the July average price of platinum increased slightly as compared with that of June, while the palladium price decreased slightly over the same time period. Platinum prices increased to a peak of \$1,336 per troy ounce on July 20 and then declined to \$1,295 per troy ounce, while palladium remained relatively flat. The average ruthenium price decreased for the third consecutive month, declining 18% as compared with that of June. The iridium price has not changed since February 13, remaining at \$450 per troy ounce. The rhodium July average price was slightly lower than the June average price, having dropped below the \$6,000-per-troy-ounce-level briefly on July 17 and 18.

Stillwater Mining Company (SMC) (Billings, MT) released preliminary second quarter production figures for 2007. For the first 6 months, mine production of platinum-group metals (PGMs) was 8,620 kg, 17% lower than that of same time period of 2006. On July 11, approximately 900 employees began a strike owing to disputes over wages and benefits. This marks the

second strike in 3 years. The new contract was accepted on July 17. In addition to a temporary work stoppage because of strike, production was also affected by changes in mine equipment and a reduction in contracted mining services. In contrast, the recycling production in the first 6 months in 2007 increased by 32% as compared with that of the same time period in 2006 (Metal Bulletin, 2007; Stillwater Mining Company, 2007a, b).
