## SILVER IN FEBRUARY 2007

U.S. mines produced 89,800 kilograms (kg) of silver in February, an 8% decrease compared with revised January production of 96,900 kg, according to the U.S. Geological Survey. The daily production rate of silver in February was 3,210 kg, 2% higher than the January rate of 3,130 kg and 0.1% more than the 2006 annual daily production rate of 3,120 kg. Silver production in the United States increased by about 3% compared with February 2006 production of 87,100 kg.

Englehard Industries' silver price peaked at \$14.69 per troy ounce on February 26 and averaged \$13.97 per troy ounce in February, an 8% increase from the average January price of \$12.94 per troy ounce, and about 46% more than the average February 2006 price of \$9.55 per troy ounce.

A scoping study to double tonnage at Hecla Mining Company's (Coeur d'Alene, ID) Lucky Friday Mine has been completed. The study outlines how to increase annual

production by 70%, extend mine life, lower cost per ounce, and increase mineable resources. Plans include \$150 to \$200 million for a new mill, a surface shaft to existing levels, and an underground shaft to more than 300 meters below the deepest identified resources. Hecla indicated a 2006 net profit of \$68.6 million, a record in the company's 116-year history (Hecla Mining Company, 2007<sup>§1</sup>).
