SILVER IN JUNE 2007

U.S. mines produced 107,000 kilograms (kg) of silver in June, a 3% decrease compared with revised May production of 110,000 kg, according to the U.S. Geological Survey. The daily production rate of silver in June was 3,570 kg, and was only slightly higher than the revised May rate of 3,550 kg and 14% more than the 2006 annual daily production rate of 3,120 kg. Silver production in the United States in June increased by about 17% compared with June 2006 production of 91,600 kg.

Englehard Industries' silver price peaked at \$13.79 per troy ounce on June 4 and averaged \$13.16 per troy ounce in June, a minor decrease from the average May price of \$13.20 per troy ounce, and was a 22% increase compared with the average June 2006 price of \$10.83 per troy ounce.

Apex Silver Mines Corporation (Denver, CO) reported that construction activities, initial production, and sales are on schedule for third quarter 2007 from its San Cristobal project in Bolivia. As of the end of May, 2,500,000 metric tons (t) of sulfide ore had been stockpiled and 100,000 t of ore had been crushed and stockpiled ahead of the mill (Apex Silver Mines Corporation, 2007).

Hochschild Mining, PLC (London, United Kingdom) indicated that it had started production at its San Jose mine in southern Argentina. The company expected the mine to produce 1,870 kg of gold and 109,000 kg of silver over the next 12

months. Production was also expected from the company's Pallancata Mine in Peru and the Mina Morisin project in Mexico in the third quarter of 2007 (Reuters, 2007).

One of the world's biggest porphyry copper/silver deposits, Toromocho, at an altitude of 4,700 to 4,900 meters in the Peruvian Andes, has been bought from Peru Copper Inc. (Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada) by the Aluminum Corporation of China (Chalco), (Beijing, China) which is one of China's leading diversified mining and metals companies. Recent ore reserve calculations reportedly indicate 1.375 billion metric tons of ore grading 0.51% copper, 7.06 grams per ton silver and 0.018% molybdenum (Williams, 2007).
