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SILVER IN AUGUST 2007

U.S. mines produced 103,000 kilograms (kg) of silver in August, a 9% increase compared with revised July production of 94,500 kg, according to the U.S. Geological Survey. The daily production rate of silver in August was 3,310 kg, and was 9% higher than the revised July rate of 3,050 kg and was 6% higher than the 2006 annual daily production rate of 3,120 kg. Silver production in the United States in August 2007 was 4% higher than August 2006 production of 99,440 kg.

Englehard Industries' silver price peaked at \$13.18 per troy ounce on August 8 and averaged \$12.37 per troy ounce in August, a 5% decrease from the average July price of \$13.03 per troy ounce, and was a 14% increase compared with the average August 2006 price of \$12.28 per troy ounce.

Revett Minerals Inc. (Spokane Valley, WA) reported net income of \$11.2 million from its Troy Mine for the 6 months ended June 30, 2007. Metals sales in the second quarter were 1,600,000 kg of copper and 11,700 kg of silver compared with

1,100,000 kg of copper and 9,370 kg of silver during the first quarter of 2007 (Revett Minerals Inc., 2007).

Apex Silver Mines Ltd., (Denver, CO) announced the first production of silver-bearing lead and zinc concentrates from its San Cristobal Mine, Bolivia. The first sale of silver-bearing lead and zinc concentrates was expected in the third quarter, and San Cristobal was expected to attain full production during the fourth quarter of 2007 (Apex Silver Mines Ltd., 2007).
