SILVER IN SEPTEMBER 2007

U.S. mines produced 94,900 kilograms (kg) of silver in September, an 8% decrease compared with August production of 103,000 kg, according to the U.S. Geological Survey. The daily production rate of silver in September was 3,160 kg, 4% lower than the August daily production rate of 3,320 kg and slightly higher than the 2006 annual daily production rate of 3,120 kg. Silver production in the United States in September 2007 was 5% lower than September 2006 production of 100,000 kg.

Englehard Industries' silver price peaked at \$13.84 per troy ounce on September 28 and averaged \$12.95 per troy ounce in September. This was a 5% increase from the average August price of \$12.37 per troy ounce, and an 11% increase compared with the average September 2006 price of \$11.62 per troy ounce.

Sterling Mining Co. (Wallace, ID) reported that its Sunshine Mine milling and concentration facility is operational and commenced processing stockpiled ore. Sustained production was forecast for December 2007 (Sterling Mining Co., 2007).

Coeur d'Alene Mines Corp. (Coeur d'Alene, ID) announced revenue of \$155.5 million for the first 9 months of 2007 compared with \$149.5 million during the first 9 months of 2006. This included \$11.1 million from the sale of the Coeur Silver

Valley properties. Coeur produced 258 metric tons (t) of silver and 2 t of gold through the first 9 months of 2007, and construction at Coeur d'Alene's San Bartolome Mine in Bolivia is on track for February 2008 production (Coeur d'Alene Mines Corp., 2007).

Endeavour Silver Corp. (Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada) announced that silver production from its properties in Mexico in the third quarter 2007 was 18 t and issued a revised production forecast of 62 t of silver for 2007. Endeavour's silver production in the third quarter 2007 was 34% higher than that of the second quarter 2007 and 74% higher than third quarter 2006 production (Endeavour Silver Corp., 2007).
