










I25 Exit 234

NM State Road 556)

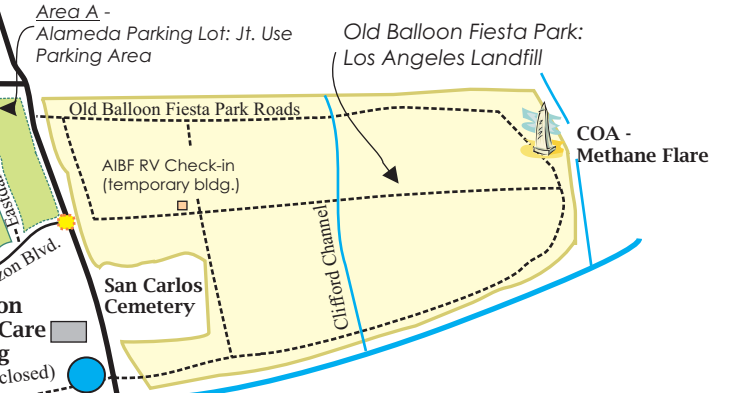
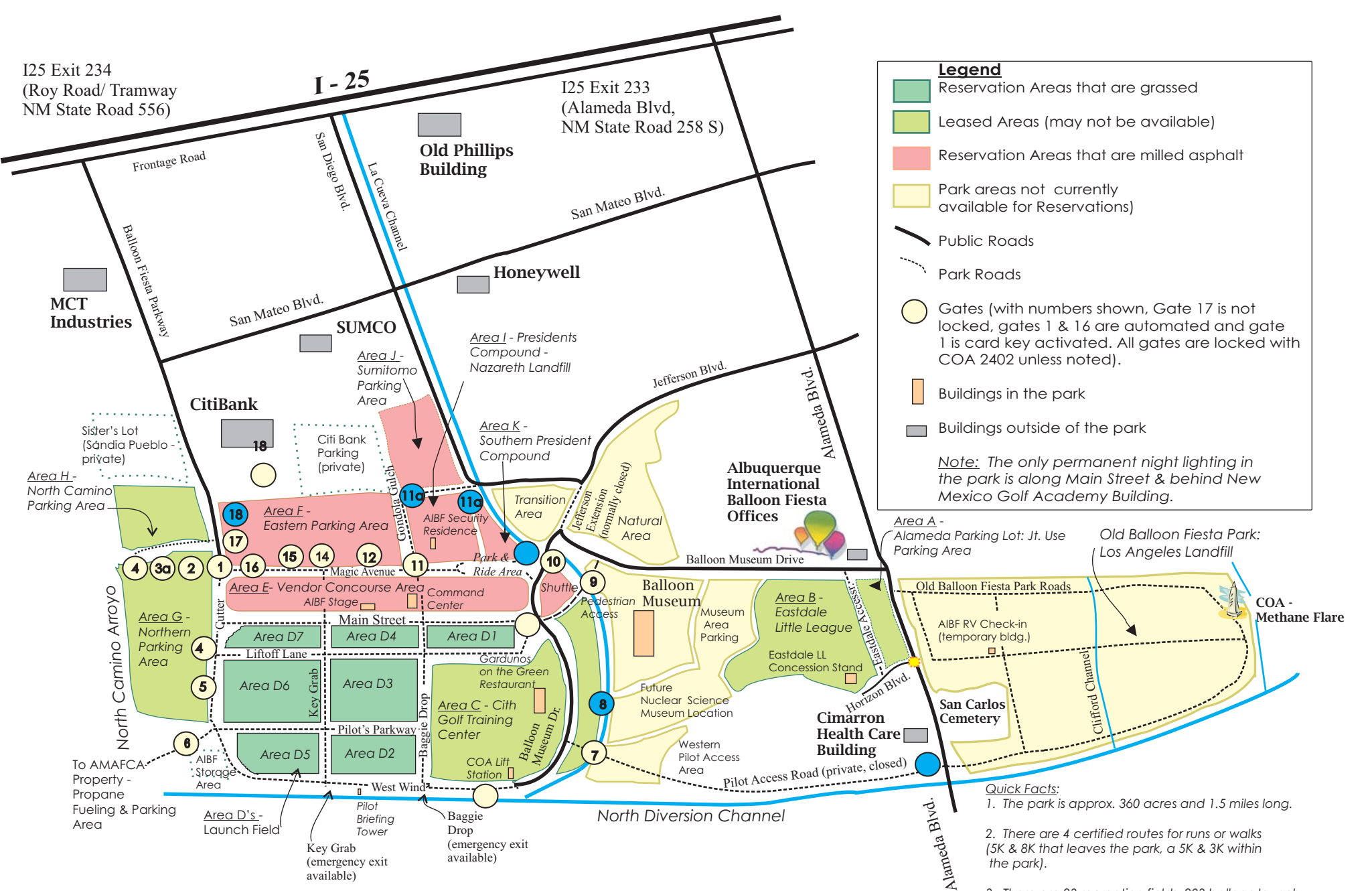

Note: The only permanent night lighting in the park is along Main Street & behind New Mexico Golf Academy Building.



- Quick Facts:**
1. The park is approx. 360 acres and 1.5 miles long.
 2. There are 4 certified routes for runs or walks (5K & 8K that leaves the park, a 5K & 3K within the park).
 3. There are 23 recreation fields, 203 balloon launch spaces (2 balloons per site per wave) and 12,000 to 15,000 parking spaces.
 4. The landscaping in the park is watered with non-potable water.
