Fishing	July 1-Nov 16, 2007 and February 1 - November 16, 2008	User Information Card Required
Scouting	Sep 14-28, 2007	Daylight use only. No weapons allowed. ATV's allowed on designated trails.
Deer-Archery	Oct 1 - Nov 9, 2007 Nov 12-16, 2007 Jan 19-31, 2008	Use or possession of any drug, or device for employing such drug for hunting is prohibited. Still Hunting Only. Either Sex. One deer per day.
Deer-Archery Cottonmouth Unit	Oct 1 - Nov 9, 2007 Nov 12-16, 2007	Use or possession of any drug, or device for employing such drug for hunting is prohibited. Still Hunting Only. Either Sex. One deer per day.
Deer - Youth Gun Hunt All open units, including Cottonmouth Unit	Nov 10-16, 2007	Ages 10-15 (on the day of the hunt). No other hunting allowed during this hunt except wheelchair dependent hunters in specified blinds. One deer per day, either sex.
Deer-Primitive Weapon	Nov 17-21, 2007 Nov 23 - Dec 23, 2007	Still Hunting Only. Either Sex. Hunter Orange <b>HAT and UPPER GARMENT</b> required. One deer per day.
Deer-Primitive Weapon	Jan 2 - 8, 2008	Bucks only. Must have at least 12 inch inside spread. One deer per day. Still Hunting Only. Hunter Orange <b>HAT and UPPER GARMENT</b> required.
Deer - Traditional Historic Weapons Only	Dec 26-31, 2007	Flintlock and sidelock percussion muzzleloaders with iron sights. Patched round balls only. <b>In-line muzzleloaders, electronic sights, scopes, fiber optic sights and conical bullets are prohibited.</b> May use recurves and longbows without sights only. One deer per day, either sex. Hunter orange hat and upper garment required.
Deer - Archery - Wheelchair Dependent Hunters Only	Oct 1 - Nov 16, 2007 Jan 19-31, 2008	Pre-registration required. Only for permanently wheelchair dependent hunters. All refuge regulations apply.
Deer - Any Legal Weapon - Wheelchair Dependent Hunters Only	Nov 17-21, 2007 Nov 23 - Dec 23, 2007 Dec 26-31, 2007 Jan 2-8, 2008	Same specific regulations as above. One deer per day, either sex.
Turkey - Permanently Wheelchair Dependent Hunters Only	State Season	Limit: one gobbler per day - 2 per season. Hunters must pre-register by telephone or mail by February 28, 2008.
Turkey - Youth Lottery Hunts Ages 10-15 Only	Mar 15-16, 2008 Mar 22-23, 2008 Mar 29-30, 2008 Apr 5-6, 2008 Apr 12-13, 2008 Apr 19-20, 2008 April 26-27, 2008	Drawing required. Limited permits. Applications must be properly completed and received by February 22, 2008. Improperly completed applications will be rejected. Limit: one gobbler per day - 2 per season. Sibley & Butler Lake Units Only
Squirrel & Rabbit - No Dogs All open units, including Cottonmouth Unit	Oct 13 - Nov 9, 2007 Nov 12 - 16, 2007	Shotguns (non-toxic shot only), .22 long rifles, and muzzleloading rifles 38 caliber and under with iron sites, shooting patched round balls only. Hunter orange
Squirrel & Rabbit- With or Without Dogs	Jan 19 -Feb 28, 2008	<b>Hunter orange HAT and UPPER GARMENT</b> required when hunting in open fields or reforested areas. No hog hunting.
Woodcock	State season after January 19, 2008	Shotguns with approved non-toxic shot only. State bag limits apply. Hunter orange <b>HAT and UPPER GARMENT</b> required when hunting in open fields or reforested areas. No hog hunting.
Raccoon - Dogs required	Feb 1-28, 2008	Sunset to sunrise only. No hunting from Carthage-Linwood Road (River Road). Use of boats and ATV's prohibited. .22 long rifles only. No hog hunting. Only raccoon and opossums may be taken.
Waterfowl - Gilliard Lake, Salt Lake, and Butler Lake	Tuesdays, Thursdays, Saturdays & Sundays during State season. 1/2 hour before sunrise til 12 noon. <b>CLOSED:</b> Nov 22, 2007, Dec 25, 2007, Jan 1, 2008	Hunters, decoys and blinds must be out of the area by 1:00pm. Non-toxic shot required. Portable blinds only. Retrievers may be used.
Waterfowl - Youth Hunt	State Zone Date	Same specific regulations as above

\* Unless otherwise stated, State season bag limits apply. One deer per day, 4 points or better. Non-residents may not harvest antlerless deer. All Refuge Regulations must be adhered to at all times by all persons using the Refuge.

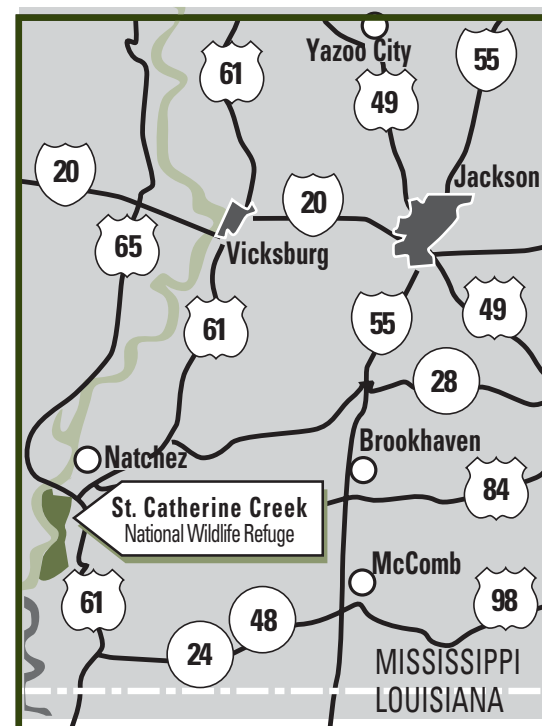
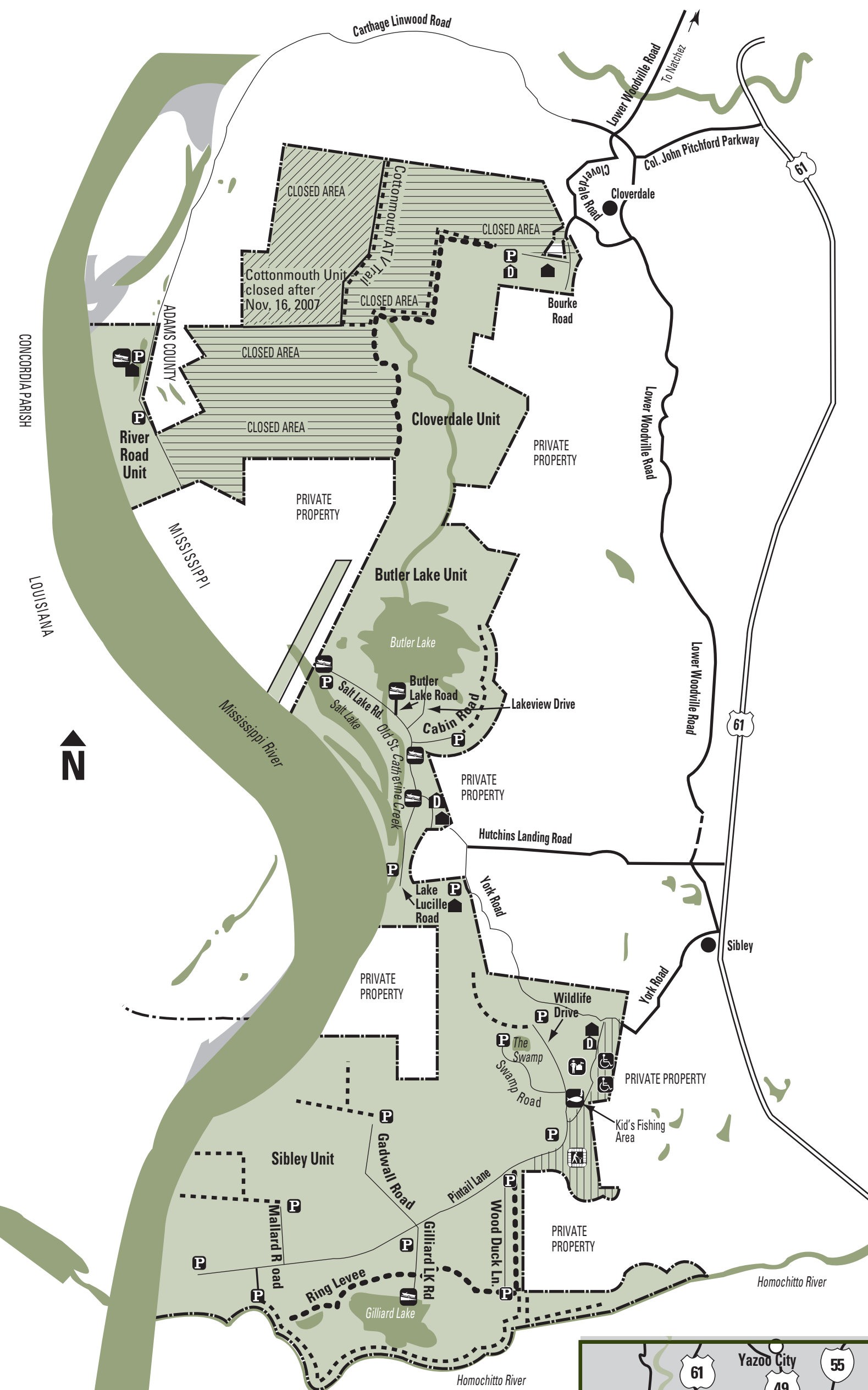
## Signs Protect Visitors and Resources.

This sign delineates the refuge boundary. Entry is permitted only for authorized uses (hunting, fishing, sight-seeing, etc.) in accordance with refuge regulations.

This area is closed to all entry. No hunting, fishing, or sight-seeing is permitted. No roads or trails are open to the public. (See map.)

This area is closed to **all** hunting. Firearms and archery equipment are strictly prohibited. (See map.)
