


Incidental Species

Nutria, Armadillo, Coyote, Beaver, Feral Hog, Raccoon. Incidental species may be taken during any open hunting season by any hunter having the required licenses and permits. There is no bag limit on armadillo, coyotes, beaver and feral hogs. State regulations apply on other incidental species.

Signs and Boundaries

Honor Refuge Boundaries: Please respect the rights of our refuge neighbors. Become familiar with refuge boundaries and avoid trespassing on private land.

Signs are useful tools in regulating the use of a public area. The wording of the sign applies to the area behind the sign. Please respect the following signs.

This sign delineates the refuge boundary. Always know the regulations before entering.

NATIONAL WILDLIFE REFUGE INAUTHORIZED ENTRY PROHIBITED

All hunting and possession of any weapon is prohibited beyond this sign.



This area is closed to all public entry. Exceptions stated on sign.



Black Bears are protected

The Louisiana black bear is listed as a threatened species under the provisions of the Endangered Species Act of 1973. It is unlawful for anyone to take, harass, disturb, etc., any Louisiana black bear. Criminal penalty: up to \$50,000 and 1 year imprisonment.
