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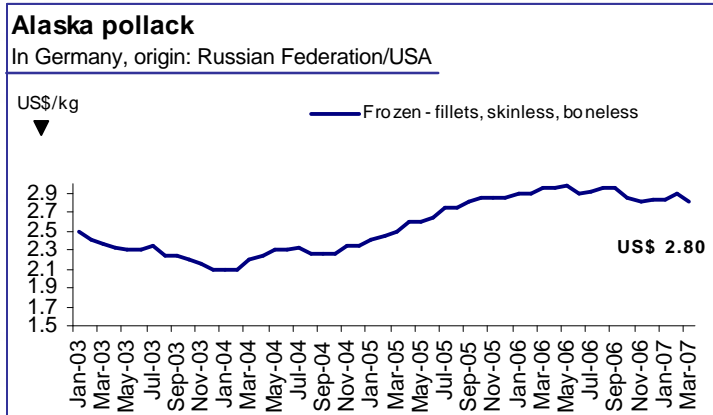
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### LATEST TRENDS

European import price trends as reported by correspondents are mixed this month with increases on February levels indicated for frozen tuna, cod fillets as well as for chilled farmed seabream and seabass. Stable to weaker prices on the other hand are evident for coldwater shrimps, round herring, pangasius fillets and chilled farmed turbot.

### GROUND FISH

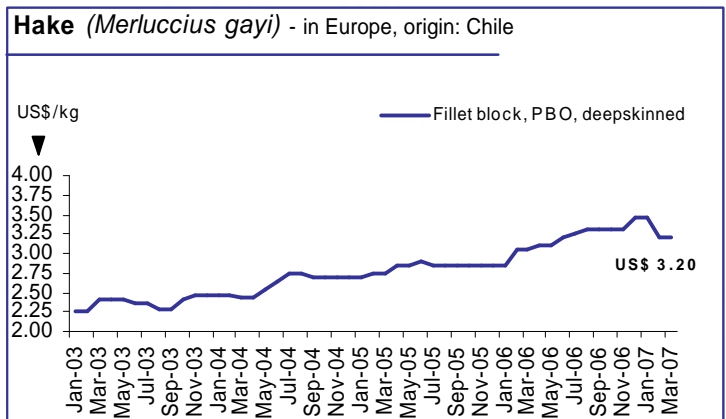


Import price indications for frozen groundfish fillets are again broadly stable this month compared to the previous month. Delivered prices for boneless Alaska pollock fillets of US origin are still quoted at

just under US\$3/kg, a level largely unchanged for the past six months. Fillets of Russian origin, on the other hand, are slightly weaker this month at US\$2.80/kg. A somewhat weaker trend is also reported for *M. hubbsi* fillets from Uruguay although recent reports of weaker

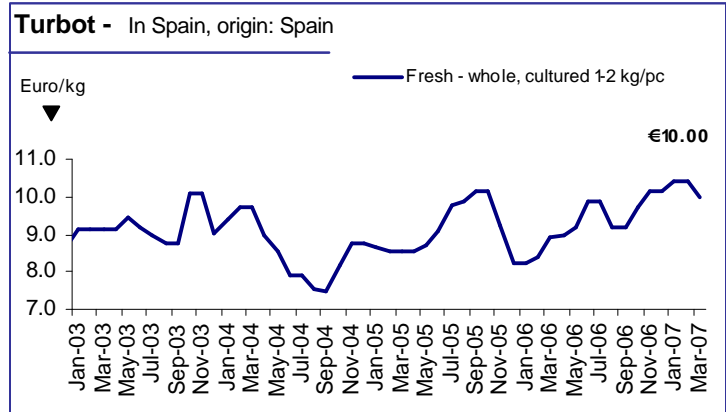
Argentinean landings at the beginning of 2007 point to a firming of *hubbsi* prices if this catch trend continues. The gradual upward movement in delivered cod fillet prices has continued in March

with boneless, skinless fillets from Poland/ Norway quoted at €5.95/kg, 2% higher than February.



## FLATFISH

Cif chilled farmed turbot prices in Spain are stable to declining compared to February indications. With steady sales during February, market conditions are described as stable and the current price trend is not expected to fluctuate significantly over the coming weeks. Reported prices for the larger grades are between 40 to 70% higher than levels indicated during March 2006.

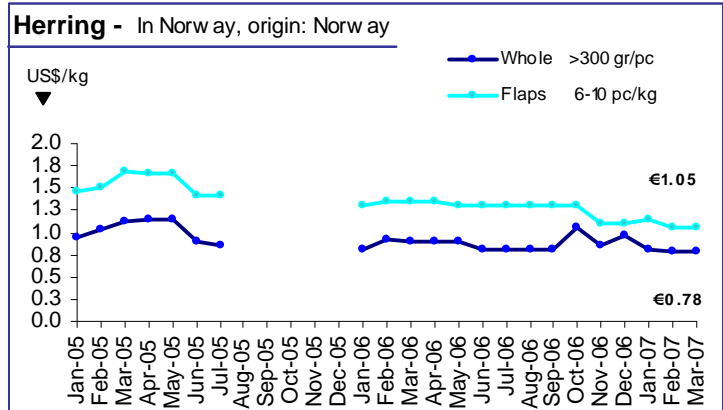


## TUNA

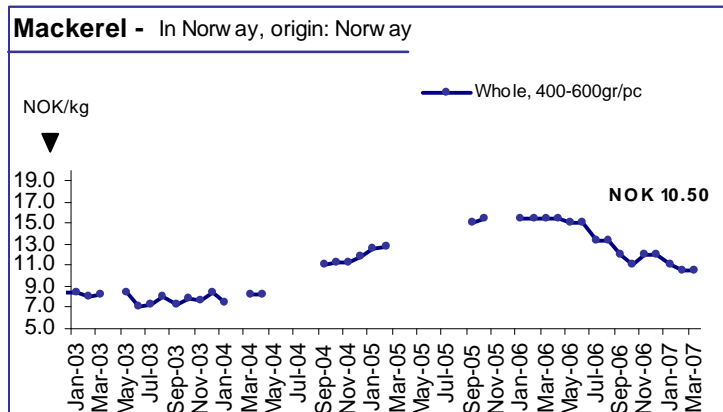
Low yellowfin landings continued in all oceans, except for the Western Pacific. Frozen whole yellowfin reached EUR1 600 FOB in the Mahé market, Seychelles, and 1 700/tonnes DEQ in Spain. Price of double-cleaned yellowfin loins reached US\$5 800 (origin: Indian Ocean). Price of frozen whole skipjack oscillated between €860 and 870/tonnes FOB in the Seychelles whilst increasing to €925 DEQ in Spain. However, the premium gained by Indian Ocean producers from the differential in skipjack prices between Vigo and Mahé is still estimated to be lower than the cost of air freight between the Seychelles and Spain. On the other hand, price of double-cleaned skipjack loins in Spain increased to US\$3 800/tonnes for loins from the Indian Ocean and US\$3 900/tonne for loins from Latin America. The competition between South America and the Indian Ocean in the loins market is quite stiff in times of low supply, high demand and high prices.

## PELAGICS

Delivered prices to St. Petersburg for frozen round herring are slightly down for the medium grades this month and a further weakening of the 300gr size is expected. With low stocks reported for the 400gr, and possibly the 350gr, sizes, prices should remain stable for these grades. Demand for frozen flaps with high fat content has been strong over the past month but with good stock levels reported in Norway, there has been no significant upward pressure on prices.



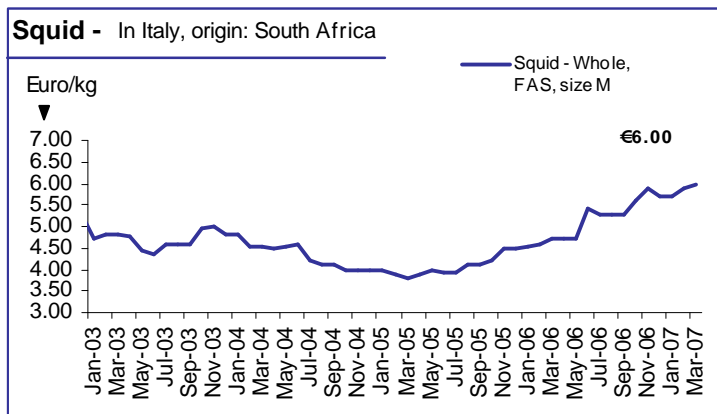
Frozen round mackerel prices remain unchanged on last month. Russian demand appears to be currently focused on the relatively cheaper Scottish product at the expense of Norwegian supplies. With reports of strong frozen mackerel inventories in



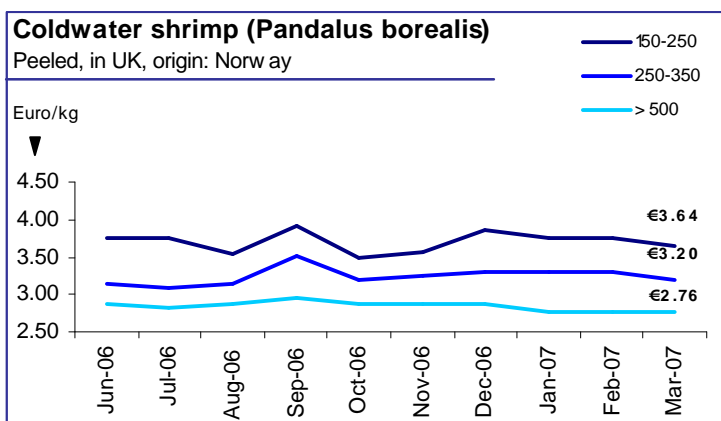
Japan from domestic landings, demand for European mackerel in the Japanese market remains subdued. Exports of Norwegian round mackerel to Japan are down 40% for the January-February period compared to the same period last year, despite an almost 20% fall in unit export values.

## CEPHALOPODS

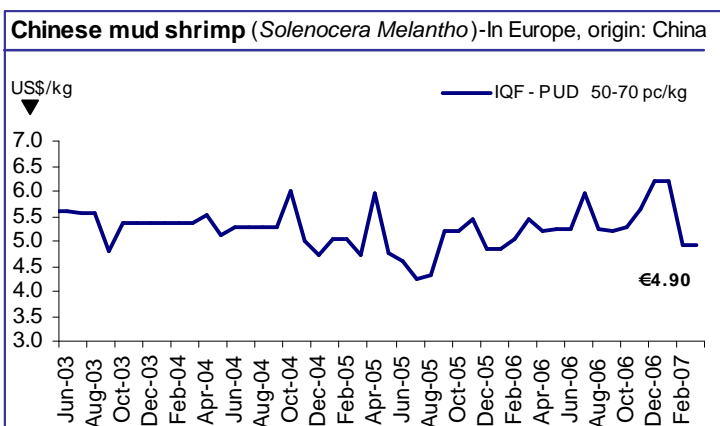
Record delivered euro prices continue to be reported for frozen at sea *loligo* squid from South Africa. Negligible stock levels due to poor landings are providing a boost to prices and exporters now fear competition in European markets from cheaper Asian product. Prices for South African product are up 1-2% this month compared with February levels.



## CRUSTACEANS



Following a stable to increasing trend in recent months, delivered UK prices for cooked peeled coldwater shrimps are reported slightly lower this month on February levels. Both the 150-250 and 200-300 pcs/lb grades are down 3% to £1.65 and £1.55/lb respectively. Price indications for the 300 pcs/lb and smaller grades remain unchanged on January levels. Ex works (dollar) prices in



Norway for cooked shell-on shrimp have been stable over the past six months although a marginal decline is reported this month.

Ahead of the new Canadian lobster season in May, demand for frozen product in north European markets is reported subdued with seasonally weak supermarket sales. Live lobster sales are reported steady on the other hand. To encourage sales in the frozen segment, current

industry efforts in North America are said to be focused on developing new value added products.

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## SALMON/TROUT

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Atlantic salmon prices in the European market have been fairly unstable over the last few weeks. The price level is fairly similar to that of 2006 and somewhat higher than for 2005. Demand is strong with many exporters reporting only limited quantities available for spot sales. With less salmon available from Chile than previously anticipated, salmon prices in the European market can be expected to remain firm over the next 2-3 months.

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## FRESHWATER FISH

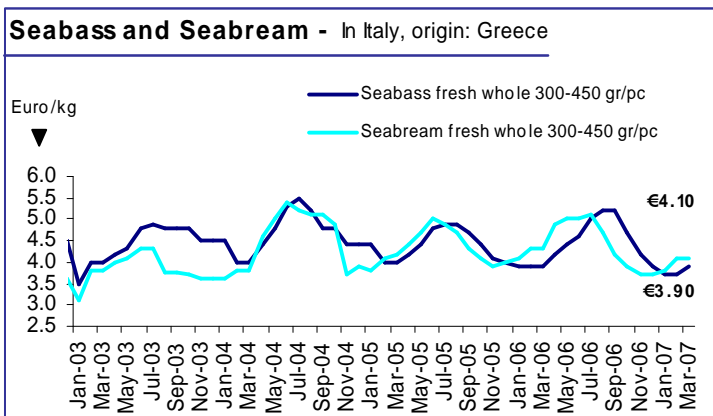
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Active price competition is reported for Vietnamese pangasius fillets with cif indications for iqf product at US\$3.50/kg, down from US\$3.80/kg indicated during the latter half of 2006. There are also signs of somewhat weaker prices in the Nile perch fillet market, cif indications for chilled fillets are reported in the €4.70-5.00/kg range compared to €5/kg last December.

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## SEABASS/SEABREAM

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Prices are on the rise for both species, in particular for bass. This is caused by the dual effect of sustained demand and tighter supplies. The rising price trend is expected to continue for at least another three months until the new generation fish reaches market size.
