
RIO GRANDE ZOOLOGICAL PARK

GENERAL INFORMATION. Zoo path walking distance is just over 2.27 miles. Plan on 2-3 hours to enjoy all exhibits. Children 12 and younger must be accompanied by an adult. Zoo security officers are present to ensure the safety of all visitors, animals and employees.

TO OUR VISITORS. Please respect other visitors and the animals and plants in these exhibits. Please do not tap on the exhibit glass or walk on any of the plants. For the safety of visitors, animals and staff, the following items are prohibited: plants, glass containers, toys, sports equipment, pets,

liquor, radios, CD players, weapons. By city ordinance, this is a non-smoking facility.
