

# How to access the Digital Library (databases):

Begin by accessing our website: [www.cabq.gov/library](http://www.cabq.gov/library)

From our home webpage look on the left hand side of the screen for: RESEARCH ASSISTANCE, and under this heading select: [Digital Library \(databases\)](#)
