FINAL ORDER


On February 16, 2000, the Director, Southwestern Region, Office of Pipeline Safety, issued to Respondent a Notice of Probable Violation and Proposed Civil Penalty (Notice), in accordance with 49 C.F.R. § 190.207. Respondent has submitted a check in the amount of the civil penalty (\$5,000), waiving further right to respond, and authorizing entry of this Final Order.

FINDINGS OF VIOLATION

Pursuant to §190.209(a)(1) and 49 U.S.C. §60122, I hereby find that Respondent violated the following section of 49 C.F.R. Part 195, as described more completely in the Notice:

1. 49 C.F.R. § 195.52(a) -- failing to provide telephonic notice of a crude oil release at the earliest practicable moment following discovery.

This finding of violation will be considered a prior offense in any subsequent enforcement action taken against Respondent. I assess the civil penalty of \$5,000, already paid by Respondent.
