On November 2-6, 1997, representatives from the Office of Pipeline Safety (OPS) in the Eastern and Southern Regions, pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an onsite inspection of your pipeline facilities and records in the Fort Mifflin Area.

It was noted that a review of the valve maintenance records for the 14-inch Twin Oaks to Willow Grove line indicated that four (4) of the mainline valves were not inspected twice for the calendar year of 1996. The second inspection was done in January of 1997.
