Dear Mr. Hagan:

On May 10-12 and August 23-27, 1999, a representative of the Central Region, Office of Pipeline Safety, pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, conducted an onsite pipeline safety inspection of your records at the Corning, NY and Seymour, IN locations and field facilities located within the state of Ohio.

The inspection disclosed the following items of concern. Please give these items your attention.

1. On the 8" A-1 line, at MP 128.45 (Valve A1-93) the right-of-way needs clearing on the east side.
2. On the 8" A-1 line, at MP 197.11 (Valve A1-134) the right-of-way needs clearing and weeds, bushes and other growth need clearing from around the valve site and from inside the fenced area.
3. On the 8" A-1 line, at MP 217.74 (Hwy 152) the right-of-way needs clearing east of the highway test station area.
4. On the 10" P-45 line, at MP 89.0 (Auglaize River) the right-of-way needs clearing on the north side.
5. On the 8" A-1 line, at MP 154.77 (railroad crossing) a TEPPCO sign/marker is needed on the east side of the tracks and the sign/marker on the west side needs to be replaced with one showing the current operator/contact number.
6. At the Lebanon Terminal, tanks 3307, 3309 and A-2 need painting to prevent atmospheric corrosion.

These items were discussed with your representatives during the inspection. They indicated that the items would receive attention.

The Office of Pipeline Safety appreciates your attention in this matter and good faith efforts to promote continued safety in your organization.
