On November 24, 2004, the Associate Administrator for Pipeline Safety, Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), formerly the Research and Special Programs Administration, issued a Corrective Action Order (CAO) in the above-referenced case. The CAO required ConocoPhillips Pipe Line Company to take certain corrective actions to protect the public and environment from potential hazards associated with a failure involving the McKee to Denver segment of the Borger-Denver pipeline system running from Borger, Texas to Denver, Colorado, and the Powder River pipeline system running from McCulloch, Wyoming to Borger, Texas. After review of the records and the work performed on these pipeline systems, the Director of the Western Region, PHMSA, has determined that ConocoPhillips has satisfactorily complied with the terms of that CAO. Accordingly, this case is now closed. No further action is contemplated with respect to the matters involved in the case. Closure of this case has no effect on any other pipeline enforcement proceedings.
