Dear Mr. Johnson:

On November 30, 2000, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) issued a Final Order to Respondent finding violations of 49 C.F.R. §§ 195.402(a) and 195.420 and assessing a civil penalty of \$25,000. On December 21, 2000, Respondent filed a Petition for Reconsideration of the Final Order. Respondent and PHMSA have entered into a Consent Agreement to resolve these issues. The Consent Agreement has been incorporated into a Consent Order issued May 19, 2006. Under the terms of the Consent Agreement, the Final Order in CPF No. 55501 will be withdrawn, as well as the civil penalty of \$25,000 that was assessed.

This case is now closed.
