#### NATIONAL CLIMATIC DATA CENTER

NATIONAL COOPERATIVE OBSERVER is prepared, funded and distributed by the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) and is provided free of charge to Cooperative Observers.

Photographs are taken by National Weather Service (NWS) employees unless otherwise noted. Narratives are prepared and submitted by the NWS. Narratives are edited only for grammatical errors, space limitations and consistency.

The Cooperative Observers Climatological Network was created in 1890. The program is currently administered by the National Weather Service, a line office of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, an agency within the Department of Commerce. One of the responsibilities of the NWS is to take meteorological observations which are used to record the climate condition in the United States. The National Weather Service relies heavily on a vast network of cooperative observer volunteers to achieve this objective.

The NWS determines where observations are needed and furnishes standard meterological instruments to individuals who volunteer their time to take a record daily weather observations of the weather. Currently, there are about 8000 published volunteer observation stations operated by individuals, many are maintained by institutions and commercial firms (universities, utility companies, etc.). All cooperative observers submit a monthly report summarizing daily observations. These contributions to the climate record of the United States are invaluable.






