Good Government Committee ("USON-GGC"), a separate segregated fund ("SSF") of U.S. Oncology Inc. ("USON").

- 1. On <u>Page 7, Line 5,</u> insert a comma after the word "medical."
- 2. Insert a new footnote on <u>Page 11</u>, at the end of the sentence on <u>Line 15</u> (which will be #8) to read as follows:

"On August 6, 2004, the Commission received a letter from the Executive Committee of the USON Policy Board discussing and supporting the USON advisory opinion request. Every Practice was to receive a copy of the letter."

concerning the application of the Federal Election Campaign Act of
1971, as amended (the "Act"), and Commission regulations to the use of
contributor information from the Commission's online public records in a
financial software system sold by NGP.

A discussion followed, and Chairman Smith proposed an amendment on Page 4, Lines 3 and 4, by deleting the remainder of the sentence after the word "purpose."

MOVED to amend draft Advisory Opinion 2004-24, as submitted in Agenda Document No. 04-69, on Page 4, Lines 3 and 4, by deleting the remainder of the sentence after the word "purpose" which reads: "because NGP is a for-profit company that sells and services NGP Campaign Office for a profit."
