Chairman Thomas recognized Mr. Jonathan Levin of the General Counsel's Office who presented draft Advisory Opinion 2005-17, concerning the application of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act"), and Commission regulations to the

Association's status as a trade association, the affiliation of American Crystal and the Association, and the ability of either the Association or American Crystal to solicit the stockholders, executive and administrative personnel, and the families thereof, of the Association's incorporated members for contributions to American Crystal's separate segregate fund, American Crystal Sugar Company Political Action Committee. During his presentation, Mr. Levin noted the following amendments:

<u>Page 1, Line 19:</u> delete the word "that" at the end of the line;

<u>Page 7, Line 8:</u> change the word "This" to "The" at the end of the line.
