Federal Election Commission Minutes of an Open Meeting Thursday, September 21, 2000

Chairman Darryl R. Wold called the Federal Election Commission to order in an open meeting at 10:05 A.M. on Thursday, September 21, 2000, with a quorum present.

I. <u>AUDIT MATTERS</u>

A. <u>Dole for President, Inc.-Statement of</u> Reasons (LRA#467)

(Held over from meeting of September 14, 2000)

Chairman Wold recognized Ms. Jamila Wyatt of the General Counsel's Office who presented the draft Statement of Reasons which determined that Senator Robert J. Dole and Dole for President, Inc. (the "Primary Committee") must repay a total of \$289,736 to the United States Treasury. The amount of \$283,481 relates to a repayment determination for a surplus of funds, and \$6,255 for the use of public funds to defray non-qualified campaign expenses.

During the ensuing discussion, Mr. Joe Stoltz and Mr. Alex Boniewicz of the Audit Division participated.

It was agreed without objection to continue this matter in the afternoon session.

The meeting recessed at 11:30 A.M.y. and reconvened at 11:35 A.M. with a quorum present.

Dole, Secretary Jack Kemp, and Dole/Kemp'96, Inc. (collectively, "the General Committee") must repay a total of \$2,624,507.99 to the United States Treasury.

A discussion was held. Mr. Joe Stoltz and Mr. Alex Boniewicz of the Audit Division were present to respond to questions and comments.

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It was agreed without objection to continue both of the audit matters at the open meeting on October 12, 2000.
