Chairman Lenhard recognized Commissioner Mason, who

MOVED to approve the legislative recommendations and the transmittal letter, for transmission to the President and Congress, as set forth in Agenda Document No. 07-28, and to authorize the legislative staff to make any technical and conforming amendments, as necessary.

There was further discussion.

The Chairman recognized Commissioner Walther, who

MOVED IN A SUBSTITUTE MOTION to exclude the Legislative recommendation titled (<u>Disclosure</u>) Increasing Certain Pre-BCRA Registration and Reporting Thresholds (Revised 2007), which begins on Page 11, Line 5, through Page 13, Line 6, of Agenda Document No. 07-28.

The substitute motion failed to carry on a vote of 1-4 with Commission Walther voting affirmatively. Commissioners Lenhard, Mason, von Spakovsky, and Weintraub dissented.

The main motion carried on the vote of 5-0 with Commissioners

affirmatively.
