The GSA Small Business GWAC Center is issuing this small business set-aside competitive RFP to solicit proposals to provide Federal government agencies with long term, integrated, Information Technology (IT) solutions on a global basis. The North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) code for this acquisition is 541512 -- Computer Systems Design Services.

This acquisition will be conducted using FAR Part 15 competitive negotiation selection procedures, utilizing the "best value" trade-off approach. Offerors shall submit one (1) electronic proposal, according to the specific proposal instructions in RFP Section L.12. All information shall be provided on CD-R (not CD-RW) compact disks. Proposals are due no later than 1:30 P.M., Central Standard Time (CST), on November 17, 2006.
