Ms. Meyer has been the Bicycle/Pedestrian and Trails Program Manager for Brevard County since 1988. Ms. Meyer is responsible for the development, implementation, coordination, and evaluation of bicycle/pedestrian education, enforcement, engineering, and encouragement programs and projects countywide. In 2000 Ms. Meyer was given the responsibility of developing and implementing the Greenways and Trails Master Plan for the Brevard Metropolitan Planning Organization.

Ms. Meyer has developed numerous community partnerships to fund and implement the Florida Bicycle and Traffic Safety Education Program in Brevard County elementary schools, as well as developing the Safe School Access Program which provides guidelines and implementation strategies to develop school walking routes and school bus stop locations. In 2004-2005 The Florida Alliance for Health, Physical Education, Recreation, and Dance awarded their Outstanding Community Service Partner to Ms. Meyer. The Florida Department of Transportation Strategic Highway Safety Plan recognized the Brevard County School based comprehensive program as a model statewide.

Ms. Meyer's educational background is in social work and served as Executive Director of the South Shore Boys Club in New York prior to her employment with Brevard County.
