VOLUME 11 OF THE HAWAII REVISED STATUTES FOR THE PURPOSE OF
CORRECTING ERRORS AND REFERENCES, AND CLARIFYING LANGUAGE,"

The purpose of this measure is to amend various sections of
volume 11 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes to correct errors and
clarify language.

Your Committees find that all of the statutory amendments
proposed by the measure are of a housekeeping nature and are done
simply to correct the types of errors noted in the title of this
bill.

Your Committees have amended this bill by:

- (1) Deleting the amendments to sections 482E-6 and 489D-8,
Hawaii Revised Statutes, as proposed in sections 48 and
79 of this bill, respectively; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity,
consistency, and style.




As affirmed by the records of votes of the members of your Committees on Consumer Protection & Commerce and Judiciary that are attached to this report, your Committees are in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. 
